ASSOCIATE DEGREES

Associate Degree programs are offered under the written consent of the Minister of Advanced Education effective August 2nd, 2014, having undergone a quality assessment process and been found to meet the criteria established by the Minister. Nevertheless, prospective students are responsible for satisfying themselves that the program and the degree will be appropriate to their needs (for example, acceptable to potential employers, professional licensing bodies, or other educational institutions).

TUITION FEES—ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

(Canadian \$) (to August 31, 2016)

Academic program students usually take a maximum of 15 credits (university programs) or 16 credits (Grade 11 & 12 Foundation programs). The cost per credit (or credit equivalent) is \$500.

Overseas applicants

Application fee	\$150
Document assessment & first-time registration fee	\$200
Tuition fee deposit	\$12,000

New international students accepted into academic programs (including academic programs with English preparation) arriving directly from overseas are expected to make a tuition deposit of \$12,000. This deposit is normally non-refundable once the student registers at Columbia College. (Note that this deposit will cover the tuition costs of 24 credits total; students who take more than 24 credits, or the equivalent, in their first two semesters will find that they will be expected to pay additional tuition fees.)

Local applicants

Application fee	\$150
Tuition fees	\$500/credit

New students accepted into academic programs (including academic programs with English preparation) transferring to the College from another institution in Canada, or students continuing their studies at Columbia College, who require a letter to extend visa or Study Permit are expected to make a tuition deposit of \$4,500. (Note that this deposit will cover the tuition costs of 9 credits total; students who take more than 9 credits, or the equivalent, in their first semester will find that they will be expected to pay additional tuition fees.)

Example

Tuition fees for university student taking 4 courses, 12 credits	\$6,000
Tuition fees for university student taking 5 courses, 15 credits	\$7,500
Tuition fees for Grade 11/12 foundation student taking 3 courses, 12 credits	\$6,000
Tuition fees for Grade 11/12 foundation student taking 4 courses, 16 credits	\$7,000*

*Special arrangement for secondary students

TUITION FEES—GENERAL ESL PROGRAMS

Full-time ESL program students usually take 23 hours per week of ESL classes. Part-time programs are also available.

Overseas and local applicants

14 weeks @ 23 hours/week	\$5,000
