

Emergency Responses: Columbia College

Information on these procedures can be found in your Orientation folder

- ▶ 1. Drop/Cover/Hold (response for earthquake)
- 2. Evacuation (e.g. fire/chemical accident)
- 3. Lockdown (e.g. dangerous intruder)
- 4. Hold and Secure (securing school because of external threat/danger)
- 5. Shelter in Place (to be used if the external environment poses a threat and staying in school will ensure safety of students/staff)
- 6. Room Clear (to be used when a room needs to evacuated in response to a medical emergency or physical altercation)
- Columbia College holds fire drills, lockdown exercises and earthquake drills each year.

Medical History Form

Purpose:

- Used in the event of a health emergency
 - may be used by nurse, ambulance attendants, physician
 - To identify your emergency contact
- To understand your history and conditions in order to help you.

Please be clear and answer all questions carefully:

- Fill out form found in your orientation package
- Leave form on your desk for assistant to pick up and nurse to check.
- See Nurse to complete or change medical information

Provincial Government Medical Insurance: MSP

BC Services Card: In B.C. public health insurance is called the Medical Services Plan – or MSP. It covers the cost of medically– necessary doctor services. Upcoming changes to the MSP system in B.C. will require international students pay \$75.00 a month to receive MSP medical benefits.





MSP (BC Services Card)

PLEASE APPLY ONLINE, AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE IN BC - THERE IS A 3 MONTH WAITING PERIOD FOR ALL NEW RESIDENTS TO BC.

If you do not receive your card within 12 weeks' time, call MSP at (604) 683-7151

Once you receive your BC Services Card, bring it to Student Services desk (Level 2, room 211) to submit your MSP number to Columbia College.

If you are younger then 16 please see the Nurse to apply for MSP by Canada Post mail.

You will need to be at least 16 years or old and either use your cell phone or computer to upload a photo or jpeg copy of your study permit.

- ·Be valid for six months or longer
- •Include the entire page, corner to corner
- •Ensure all text is legible and photo is in focus

 If you change your BC address or documented status (study permit, work permit, PR status, citizenship) you must inform MSP of the change!

- Must be covered until the last day of the last month of study
- Insures you for five million dollars Canadian

Private Medical Insurance Provider:

- Ask for card printout at Student Services
