

# **OPEN WORK PERMIT FOR SPOUSE**

# Who can get a work permit as the spouse or common-law partner of a student?

Your spouse or common-law partner may be eligible for an open work permit if you:

- have a valid study permit **and**
- are a full-time student at one of these types of schools:
  - a public post-secondary school, such as a college or university, or CEGEP in Quebec
  - o a private college-level school in Quebec
  - a Canadian private school that can legally award degrees under provincial law (for example, Associate Bachelors, Masters or Doctorate degree)

### How long is the open work permit valid for?

Your spouse or common-law partner's work permit will be valid for the same period of time as your study permit.

### How to apply

In most cases, your spouse or partner must apply online for a work permit.

How applying online helps applicants:

- No courier fees or mail delivery time IRCC gets their application instantly.
- Their applications may be processed more quickly.
- It helps them make sure their application is complete before they submit it.
- They can quickly submit more documents online (if IRCC asks you to).
- They get updates on the status of their application directly in their online account.

# DOCUMENTS YOU MUST GIVE YOUR SPOUSE (APPLICANT)

- 1. Confirmation of Enrollment from Columbia College
  - You can request this from Main Reception Office and regular processing time is 2 business days. Rushed service is \$20 and you can pick it up within 2 hours (Cut-off is 3PM).
- 2. A copy of your Marriage Certificate
- 3. A copy of your passport
- 4. A copy of your study permit
