

WELCOME UT CHEMISTRY 123, 210 & 220 LAB STUDENTS TO COLUMBIA COLLEGE

Fall semester - September 2020

QUICK FACTS (as of August 28, 2020, subject to change – please continue to check your portal)

- Before coming to the College, assess yourself using the Columbia Safe App (available in the App Store for free). Do not enter the building if you are not feeling well or if you were in close contact with a person with a confirmed case of Covid-19.
- 2. An optional hands-free temperature scanner is available by the Main door. Exit the building if your temperature is elevated and contact your instructor.
- Enter through the Main doors (with your mask on) and follow the arrows up the atrium stairs to the 4th Floor. Do not go to other areas of the building.
- 4. **Exit** through Stairwell #1 on the north-west side of the floor (with your mask on). Do not exit down the atrium stairs.
- 5. The elevator is reserved for those with special needs only and requires assistance from the security guard.
- 6. UT Chenistry Student should only be on College premises to attend the lab they are registered in.
- If you arrive early please go directly to the 4th floor. If you arrive before the lab is available you can wait in the 4th floor Student Lounge. Please arrange to go home as soon as your lab is over.
- **8.** Students and Instructors will access the Chemistry lab throught the Biology Lab. The exit is through the Chemistry Lab door.
- 9. If you feel sick or develop a temperature while in the College, please put on a mask immediately, notify your instructor and go directly home. If you are waiting for a safe ride home go down Stairwell #1, walk around to the Main doors, go to the security desk and a security guard will guide you to an isolation room.
- 10. Pay parking is open Monday to Friday from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. You may exit at any time.
- 11. Your lab instructor will provide education and training pertaining to lab safety procedures during Covid-19 before your first lab the week of September 8th, 2020.
