

CANADIAN MOBILITY EXCHANGE BURSARY

Columbia College has a limited number of bursaries available to qualified students who are Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or international students who have graduated from a Canadian high school program within the last 18 months.

ELIGIBILITY

- Qualified for University Transfer or Associate Degree Program
- Canadian citizens or permanent residents
- International students who have graduated from the Canadian high school system with a B average in 4 Academic Grade 12 subjects or 2.5 GPA from college on a minimum 9 credits
- Must be willing to study full time and maintain 2.0 GPA. Continuation of bursary is subject to semesterly check ins at the discretion of Recruitment Manager and annual budget

New bursary applicants must submit a short essay describing (a) why they wish to attend Columbia College, (b) how they can make a positive contribution to college life, and (c) evidence and description of participation in extracurricular activities at a previous school(s).

Continuing students who wish to apply for a bursary must present a minimum GPA of 2.5 from their previous semester, be recommended by two Columbia College instructors, and provide proof of having made a positive contribution to college-organized activities (once face to face classes resume).

Bursary students must demonstrate a willingness and commitment to participate in extra-curricular activities or peer tutoring while studying at Columbia College once face to face classes resume.

FEES

Tuition fees will be assessed at \$125 per credit for 2020/21. (\$375 per 3-credit course; \$500 per 4-credit course)

New students require a tuition deposit of \$1,155 (9 credits tuition fee plus the activity fee of \$30) prior to receiving a registration appointment.
