Computing Science Major (B.Sc.)

Students transferring to SFU Computer Science must have completed at least 24 transferable credits, including the following:

CC Courses

- One of Math course chosen from CC's MATH 113, 114, 120, 221, 252
- One of Computer Science course chosen from CC's APSC 160, CSCI 125, 150, 225, 250
- One other Math or Computer Science course from the above 2 lists

Notes:

- ENGL 100 with a grade of C- satisfies the language proficiency requirement for admission to SFU.
- The B.Arts Degree requires that students do a concentration of at least 15 credits in Arts, at least 6 of which must be upper level.
- SFU requires 2 additional lower level courses that CC does not offer: CMPT 276 and 295.
- SFU has lower level Breadth requirements for graduation; they can be taken at CC or at SFU:
 - One W (Writing) course: ENGL 100 or 101
 - Two Hums (Humanities) courses: Art 100, ENGL 108/110/121/131, HIST 110/120, PHIL 101/102
 - Two Socs (Social Sciences) courses: ANTH 110, CMNS 110, CRIM 100/150, ECON 101/103/105, GEOG 100, PSCI 100/101, PSYC 110/120, SOCI 110/120
