

Canadian Mobility Exchange Program- Canada-Ukraine Authorized for Emergency Travel

Columbia College is offering a limited number of Bursaries for Ukrainian's wishing to study in Canada. Under the Canadian Mobility Exchange Program, we're offing Ukrainian students a Domestic Free structure. Tuition is assessed at the rate of \$125/credit, which means one year of fees (30 credits) will be approximately \$3720 CAD. You'll be responsible for paying your fees in advance of registration each semester, and continuation of the program is subject to a review with your Settlement Support Staff at Columbia College. To be eligible for this program, students must be under 30 years old and qualify for an Undergraduate Level Program only (no Masters, Post-Graduate, or previous degree holders).

To determine eligibility for this program, please provide the following information:

- I) Copies of Academic Transcripts in English. If you do not have these, please provide a written summary of your academic qualifications in an email
- II) Copy of Passport/Identification Documents available
- III) Copy of Canada CUAET Authorization Letter and Work Permit (if in Canada)
- IV) Intended Program of Study and Start Date

We look forward to welcoming you here at our campus and in Canada, but before you proceed with your travels to Canada, it's important for you to understand what you're entitled to upon arrival, and what you'll be responsible for financially. Therefore, kindly review the information below before proceeding with your deposit to Columbia College.

Please review our <u>Estimated Living Costs</u> as it is important for you to be aware that you are responsible for your own living expenses for the duration of your stay in Canada. Columbia College cannot assist you in financing your living expenses, so please ensure you can plan accordingly. There are some <u>Resources available for Ukrainians</u> via Settlement Organizations, therefore you're welcome to review those here from Mosaic, a non-profit organization that assists newcomers and refugees in Canada. Please be advised that Columbia College can only assist in Homestay for housing placements, which are often competitive, but generally available. Please review our <u>Homestay Program</u> and the Fees accordingly if you wish to access this service.

Please also note that the Canadian Mobility Exchange Program is a Bursary Program, therefore, students are expected to study full-time, maintain a 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate a willingness to commit to extra-curricular activities while studying at Columbia College. To secure placement for Winter, 2023, students are required to register in a minimum of 9 credits and pay a tuition deposit of \$1,350.00, which includes medical insurance, activity fees, and 9 credits of tuition.
