

MODES OF DELIVERY: WINTER 2023



University Transfer, Associate Degree, University Preparatory

Students with valid or approved student visas/Study Permits

- Studies will be delivered in person and on campus
- Students must arrive in Vancouver by January 2, 2023, at the latest, to attend mandatory three-day orientation in person (January 3 January 5, 2023)

Students with Study Permit applications still in process

- Studies will be delivered online
- Orientation and course registration will be completed online (December 28, 2022, January 3 January 6, 2023)

Late arrivals due to visa approval delays could be accommodated on a case-by-case basis. Email orientation@columbiacollege.ca for more information.

TO-DO ASAP: CONFIRM ENROLLMENT



If your Study Permit application has been approved or in the process of approval:

- 1. Fill out our Enrollment Confirmation Form online by December 28, 2022, and upload a copy of your IRCC Study Permit Approval Letter or visa stamp:

 - You can only complete this form once duplicate entries are not allowed
 - Enrollment Confirmation Form is currently live on our website, an email with instructions was sent on November 24, 2022.

2. Confirm your Orientation schedule

- Our team will contact you to schedule your Math Placement Test (MPT)
- We will provide your orientation schedule after you complete your MPT
- Please be patient, as we process a high volume of inquiries



Travel: Preparation, Requirements, Documents

TRAVEL DATES



- Students should be in Canada by January 2, 2023, at the latest, to attend orientation in person
- Students are recommended to travel to Canada <u>not earlier than 3 weeks</u> prior to classes starting
 - Suggested travel dates: from December 19, 2022 and onwards
 - You may be denied entry by the CBSA officer if you arrive too early

Note that the College will be closed on December 20 — December 26, 2022, and on December 30, 2022 — January 2, 2023.

ENTERING CANADA



The government of Canada lifted all COVID-19 restrictions and you are no longer required to:

- Carry your proof of vaccination
- Take PCR test before or after arrival
- Download and fill out the ArriveCAN app



72 hours before your departure

DEPARTURE: DOCUMENT CHECKLIST



- Proof of Medical Insurance
- Letter of Acceptance (LOA) from Columbia College
- Digital and Physical copies of both vaccinations (if available)
- Originals or certified true copies of all academic documents
- Passport

NOTE: You no longer require a Travel Letter to enter Canada — your LOA is sufficient.

- Some dressy and traditional clothes


A FEW REMINDERS

- Access your Columbia College email account
- If you have received your student visa, completed the Enrollment Confirmation Form, and have provided all required documents, you will be given your Columbia College student credentials for your email and Microsoft 365 accounts
- Please make sure your email is updated with Admissions and check your Spam/Junk folder often!

DECEMBER 14, 2022

- Connect with your dedicated Student Engagement Ambassador (SEA)
- You will be contacted by your dedicated SEA through your College email and Teams accounts
- **SEAs are current Columbia College students** who are here to answer your questions, help through the registration process and support you to be ready to start your classes on January 9, 2022.

- Organize group meetings and discussions for you to get to know other students and make new friends
- Provide tutorials and information guides on important steps to follow
- Support with your registration
- Help make sure that you are prepared to start classes

December 19 - December 29, 2022

- Attend your Welcome & Registration online sessions
- You will be invited to attend a variety of information sessions related to your program, registration, and preparing your classes. We will send this information to you through your CC email account – keep checking for updates about these sessions.
- Attendance at these sessions is mandatory for your registration to be completed
- The last day to register is Friday, January 6, 2022

December 28, 2022

 All students must confirm that they are planning to register for the Winter 2023 semester by this date

December 29, 2022 - Complete the Columbia 101 module

- You will receive access to your Columbia 101 module on Moodle.
- Columbia 101 is a self-paced program that is designed to help you learn about all the support services that CC offers, as well as get used to our learning platforms so you are ready to begin your classes.

December 28, 2022 & January 3 - 6, 2023

ON-CAMPUS ORIENTATION

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Fill out the **Enrollment Confirmation Form** to receive your Orientation Appointment
- Take the Math Placement Test (all university level students)
- Complete the Columbia 101 Moodle module
- Attend your orientation and information sessions
- Provide a scanned copy (photo) of your Study Permit after your arrival in Canada

MATH PLACEMENT TEST (MPT)

- All university-level students are required to take the MPT before registration.
- You will be contacted by a member of our Admissions team about scheduling a date and time for your MPT after you complete the Enrollment Confirmation Form.
- This test is mandatory for all post-secondary programs (University Preparatory, University Transfer, and Associate Degree)
- DO NOT miss your MPT your registration may be delayed

MEDICAL INSURANCE

We recommend that all students who are travelling in advance to begin their studies in Canada in Winter 2023 purchase medical insurance before their arrival in the case that medical treatment is required.

Our international student insurance provider, **guard.me**, can provide insurance to students from their arrival date at a cost of \$1.65 per day of coverage using this link:

https://www.guard.me/columbiacollege/department/early-arrivals.

You will be able to purchase insurance until December 31, 2022, and you will need your Columbia College student ID number to proceed.
