

HIGH SCHOOL (GRADE 10-11-12)

We offer a tri-semester system that includes three intakes per year in January, May, and September. Students can take up to 12 courses per year which helps them to graduate faster. There are 4 options:

- Senior Secondary (Grade 10, 11, 12)
- Accelerated Secondary (Grade 11 & 12)
- Adult Secondary (for students over the age of 18)
- University Preparatory

ENGLISH REQUIREMENT AND PLACEMENT

Students combine English with academic studies based on their individual level, which means they receive an Offer of Admission into an Academic Program, plus English. Students must submit IELTS/TOEFL, or write our Language Writing Assessment to determine their English level.
