Students also need to be on track to complete a total of 24 credits by the end of April.</p> <p>Students wishing to transfer to UVIC Business must complete their 2nd year of pre-Commerce at UVIC or they can reapply for entry into Year 3.</p> <p>Min. 54 credits by April (including all required courses) to be admitted to 3rd year of Core Commerce. 60 credits must be completed before September entry. Contact a BCom Advisor. - All students must complete 60 credits (UVIC 30 units) before entering 3rd year. - Students are advised <u>not</u> to take CC's 2nd year Business courses, as UVIC requires that these courses be taken in 3rd year at UVIC. A max. of 9 credits of commerce-related courses may be used as part of the 60 credits of pre-commerce courses.
