Program Highlights

Eligibility

To qualify, Columbia College students must:

- Earn 60 Credits at CC.
- Maintain a GPA of 2.0 (C Average) on all applicable coursework.



Program Formats

Full-time:

- Cohort model with dedicated classmates for networking and collaboration
- 2 intakes: January and September
- 5 terms: four 15-week terms and one 4-week term
- Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 5:30 pm at the Downtown campus

Part-time:

- 3 intakes: January, April, and September
- Evening and weekend classes, with up to 7 years for completion
- Blended delivery (on-campus and online)
