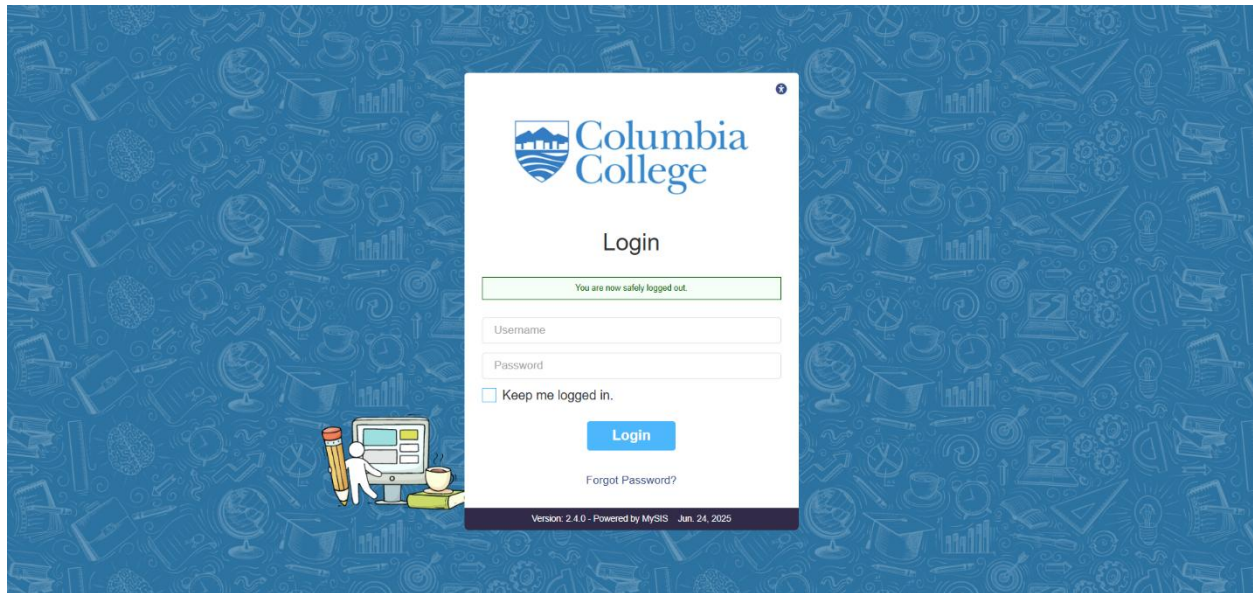
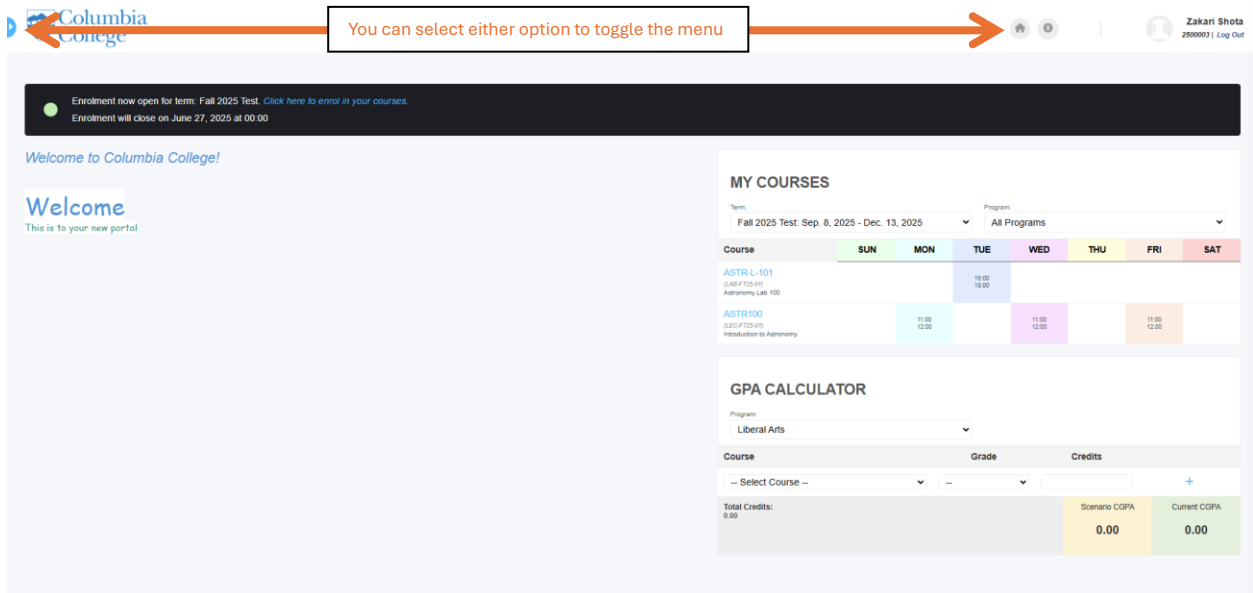


How to Register Courses
